The globally shared moral ideal of democracy as a way of living together (John Dewey) depends on every citizens' ability to solve conflicts on the basis of universal moral principles through thinking and discussion rather than through violence, deceit, and power. Without this moral competence, that is, without being able ourselves to solve conflicts, we need to give power to others (e.g., to parents, teachers, politicians, judges, police, administrators, etc.) in order to solve our conflicts, and by doing so we submit ourselves to an authority. ... more [click here for access code]
